Stallion Dantsu Seattle Passes Away

JBBA stallion Dantsu Seattle (Sunday Silence - Call Me Goddess) passed away from the infirmities of old age on September 24 at the age of 30. The stallion had been pensioned from stud duty since 2017.

Dantsu Seattle, who raced in Japan from 2 to 5 with a career record of 14 starts and 8 wins, was the winner of the 1994 G1 Takarazuka Kinen.

He entered stud in 1997 and his progeny in Japan include Himawari Sho winner Kosei Roman and Open-class winners Bergamot Seal and Kashino call Me.
