Stallion Boston Harbor Passes Away

JBBA stallion Boston Harbor (Capote - Harbor Springs) passed away from the infirmities of old age on March 9 at the age of 27. The stallion had been pensioned from stud duty at the JBBA's Shizunai Stallion station since 2016.

Boston Harbor, who won 6 of 7 starts, including the 1996 Breeders' Cup Juvenile, earned North American Champion 2-Year-Old Colt honors that year. After entering stud in the U.S.A. in 1998, he was relocated to Japan from the 2002 breeding season.

His offspring include G1 winner Healthy Addiction and Graded Stakes winners Boston Common and My Boston Gal in the U.S.A., as well as Graded Stakes winners Excuse, Daiwa Bandit and Wonderful Days in Japan.
